Broken Promises

The UN's goal to provide education for all young people by 2030 is unlikely to be achieved. Globally, of the estimated 263m children who do not go to school, 135 million live in Commonwealth countries. Millions more do not complete a secondary education. Despite this it is commonly accepted that access to an education radically reduces poverty and increases security.

"International support for education from the OECD nations amounts to less than \$10 per child across the low and middle economy countries of the Commonwealth, barely enough to pay for a text book let alone a school education" Gordon Brown,

Educate a Girl

In the UK our daughters are guaranteed a free place in school and girls are safe. Girls will be encouraged to learn, to achieve and ultimately to play an active role in society.

Life is completely different for girls in two thirds of the low and middle

economy Commonwealth countires. Even if girls finish primary school, many never get the chance to complete their secondary education, the result of many different factors.

Commonwealth girls may face major challenges as a result of poverty, disease (such as Ebola or HIV/AIDS), climate change, FGM, war, conflict and discriminatory norms (such as child marriage), which curtail their chances of a complete and/or successful education.

When a girl stays in school life improves not only for her but also for many others in her family and community. Girls who complete secondary education are more likely to have smaller and healthier families, earn higher wages and have lower risks of disease. They will also ensure their own children and others in their communities are educated.

Imagine a world where inspired FRIENDS across the Commonwealth wanted to see inspired girls in the Commonwealth educated!

A world where girls who are educated and empowered through secondary education become agents of change for others in their communities and countries; through the friendship of Commonwealth citizens everywhere.

A gift of £100 pa plus Gift Aid will provide £125 towards one girl's education for a year. A gift of £500 plus Gift Aid will provide £625 and pay for at least one girl to go to school for a whole year. A gift of £1,000 plus gift aid will pay for more than two girls to go to school for a whole year or could pay for at least one girl to complete their secondary education.

What's stopping us?

The cost of schooling is a key hurdle for girls completing their education. The Commonwealth Girls Education Fund (CGEF) sponsors capable girls in over 30 Commonwealth countries where without financial assistance they would be unlikely or unable to continue their secondary schooling. Grants of up to £500 per girl a year are used to pay for school and exam fees plus other required costs like uniforms, books, transport, meals and equipment needed by girls with disabilities.

Why CGEF?

Three key values of the
Commonwealth are: Access to
Education, Gender Equality and the
Importance of our Youth. The CGEF
has held these as core values for
50 years and has supported almost
3,000 girls in graduating from high
schools in over 40 Commonwealth
countries, helping to give them
a sense of their own worth and
empowering them to act as
ambassadors for female education in
their own countries.

We deliberately focus our attention on small numbers of girls so that we can develop a reciprocal and useful relationship with each student. This enables us to witness the life changing impact that each girl makes on the ground.

What it costs to sponsor a girl through FRIENDSHIP and the difference you can make

"The CGEF did not just make a difference to my life – it made a difference to the life of my entire family. I could pay my school fees and buy basic schoolbooks and uniform. I still walked the 20km from my home to school and went without lunch, but my mother became the envy of my neighbourhood". Ladi Dariya

Each year we sponsor up to 400 girls through secondary school. Girls receive grants of between £125 and £500 each year, amounts being tailored to the local cost of their specific needs. Girls are sponsored for 2-6 years depending on the education systems of each country. We keep in touch with our girls through an Alumnae Association.
